



MASTER'S DEGREES

The University of Granada offers a wide selection of high-quality training programmes in all fields of knowledge with a clear international vocation. With a community of nearly 57,000 students, 11% of our Undergraduate students and 27% of our Postgraduate students are international.

Currently, the UGR offers more than 100 official master's degrees, including 4 Erasmus Mundus programmes, 20 international double degrees, 16 blended and online learning programmes, 2 bilingual programmes (Spanish-English) and 3 taught completely in English.
