All international students admitted to UAGM International Exchange Program are require to comply with the following insurance coverage as required for all J1 Visa students by the US Department of State: "Medical benefits of at least \$100,000 per accident or illness; repatriation of remains in the amount of \$25,000; expenses associated with medical evacuation of the exchange visitor to his/her home country in the amount of \$50,000; and a deductible not to exceed \$500 per accident or illness" (22 CFR 62; 62.14 Insurance).
