Master Programme Erasmus Mundus “CIMET” (Color in Informatics and Media Technology) -Scholarship of 20.000€ for European Students

Short Description: In September 2008, the Erasmus Mundus Master Programme “CIMET” was launched by the European Commission “Education & Training” and is taught at four European Universities: the University of Saint-Etienne (France), the University of Eastern Finland (Finland), the University of Granada (Spain) and the University College Gjøvik (Norway). The teaching language is English.

The Master CIMET has been given the prestigious label of **Erasmus Mundus** due to its excellence. It is a **two-year course (120 ECTS)** which is broadly interdisciplinary, encompassing photonics, computer vision and imaging science, computer science and multimedia technology as a mix of relevant theoretical and practical knowledge.

Students will be awarded a **double (or multiple) degree, at postgraduate-level (Msc in Science, 300 ECTS)**, from the two (or three) degree-granting Universities visited.
