Master Programme Erasmus Mundus "CIMET" (Color in Informatics and Media Technology) - Scholarship of 20.000€ for European Students

Short description: M.Sc. CIMET is a first class and unique European Master's programme providing a comprehensive and interdisciplinary approach to the field of imaging science, photonics, computer vision, optics and multimedia technology. The study programme is geared towards both scientific research and applicative research for all major industries.

CIMET is one of the Master Courses selected by the prestigious Erasmus Mundus programme of the European Commission through which students from non-European Union countries and European Union countries are eligible for two-year grants of up to €24,000 per year.

Master Programme Erasmus Mundus "GEMMA" (Women's and Gender Studies)

Short description: GEMMA Erasmus Mundus Master's Degree in Women's and Gender Studies is an interdisciplinary programme that provides high quality academic education and professional competences for students wanting to conduct further research, and personnel working or intending to work, in the areas of Women's Studies, Gender Studies and Equal Opportunities.

GEMMA is a master of excellence supported by the European Commission which selected it as Erasmus Mundus from within 160 project proposals for 2006. It is, therefore, the first Erasmus Mundus Master in Women's and Gender Studies in Europe. GEMMA provides the added value of mobility between two of the seven participating European universities and the unique possibility to obtain a double Master's diploma from both the Home and Mobility institution.

- from the 1st of March 2011 until the 30th of April 2011 for Third Country and European students who do not wish to apply for an Erasmus Mundus grant

Master Programme Erasmus Mundus "EUROPUBHEALTH" (European Public Health)

Short description: The EUROPUBHEALTH Erasmus Mundus Masters course provides a high level education in the field of public health.

Its main goal is to enable the students to improve health of specific population groups and the population as a whole through:

- the designing, planning, implementation, advising and assessment of health prevention and promotion programmes.
- o the management of health and social services and establishments.

It is designed to provide students with methods, analytical tools and conceptual knowledge required to understand public health issues.

It is based on the acquisition of academic knowledge and basic savoir-faire related to public health as well as all the necessary skills for the various functions that the students, as future public health professionals, will embrace at the local level, regional, national, European or international, in the public or the private sectors.
