The IV Granada International Student Theatre Festival - November 2011

Short description: The University of Granada currently organises various events each year to foster awareness of ongoing theatrical projects both within

the university community as well as in collaboration with other Spanish, European and non-European universities.

These activities emerge out of our ongoing commitment to university theatre; indeed, we are proud to have sponsored past projects which have gone on to enjoy wider recognition in the city of Granada or throughout Spain.

Our annual international theatre festival (*Festival Internacional de Teatro Universitario de Granada*) allows us, for one week each November, to celebrate the scenic arts in the context of international dialogue and exchange of ideas, with special emphasis on the formation of an awareness of the theory and practice of theatre.

This year, the UGR, in preparation for the 4th Annual University Theatre Festival in November 2011, wishes to open up an invitation to other Universities to submit projects and ideas for theatrical cooperation by no later than **May 30th 2011** so that they can be evaluated by a selection committee.

The committee formed by the Director of the Cultural Extension Office, the Director of the Theatre Events Area and the Director of the Festival, will evaluate the projects in June to decide which proposals to include in the 2011 Festival.

The UGR opens its International University Centre (IUC) in Mostar to its Partner Universities

Short description: With the major aim of trying to impulse and to facilitate cross-collaboration between both local Institutions in the field of Higher Education, the University of Granada has developed a training infrastructure in Mostar that we share with the University Dzemal Bijedic and the University of Mostar. This joint facility is currently placed at the North side of the Spanish Square of Mostar, a very centric and symbolic location of the city. Today its location is still rather close to the line bordering the neighbourhood communities (Croat and Bosniac) that currently share the city and own both local universities.

The facility in Mostar, initially devoted for training in Applied Biology and EU Languages and Cultures includes complete specific equipment and media resources. If you want to organise summer courses, workshops, etc. in Mostar, the University of Granada welcomes any initiative from its Partner Universities. Short description: The dual Russia-Spain/Spain-Russia year was officially inaugurated on February, 25th, 2011. - **12th edition of the "Jornadas hispano-rusas de Traducción e Interpretación" (Hispanic-Russian Conference on Translation and Interpretation)** (Granada, 11th and 12th April 2011).

New fixed online application periods for all students exchange mobilities

Short description: The UGR has established new fixed online application periods for all students exchange mobilities (Erasmus, Exchange and Free Mobility). From the academic year 2011/2012 onwards the dates for the online applications will be:

Erasmus

- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 1st semester or for the whole academic year: 1 – 31 May
- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 2nd semester: 1 – 31 October

Exchange

- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 1st semester or for the whole academic year: 1 March – 30 April

- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 2nd semester: 1 – 31 October

Free Mobility

- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 1st semester or for the whole academic year: 15 April – 15 May
- ✓ For students coming to the UGR in the 2nd semester: 15 October – 5 November

Short description: The *Centro de Lenguas Modernas* offers not only its now renowned Spanish Courses for Foreigners (Hispanic Studies Course (CEH), Studies in Spanish Language and Culture Course (CLCE), Intensive Spanish

Language Courses (CILE), Intensive Spanish Language and Culture Course (CILYC), Spanish as Foreign Language Course (CELE), Spanish as a Foreign Language Diploma (DELE) and Optional January Course (CCE)) but also a variety of Foreign Language Courses (English, French, Italian, German, Catalan, Arabic, Japanese, Portuguese, Russian and Swedish). Here foreign students can share their daily lives with those of Spanish students, thus stimulating a mutual interest in their different languages and cultures. This contact is strengthened through a language exchange service, which gives students the opportunity to practice their Spanish outside the classroom, and by cultural visits and activities.
