

**Arqus Call for Applications Academic Year 2019/2020:
Action Line 4 – Multilingual & Multicultural University
Programme 4.5 Workshops for Staff Teaching in English:
Internationalising your Curriculum
at the University of Graz**

The Arqus European University Alliance is a cooperation between the Universities of Bergen, Granada, Graz, Leipzig, Lyon, Padua, and Vilnius, which is funded by the European Commission.

Among other activities, Arqus will support staff participation in staff development workshops relating to the promotion of multilingualism and multiculturalism at partner universities, offering fee waivers and funding travel and accommodation expenses.

Annex III contains a detailed description of the first offer of places on **staff development** courses on **teaching in English** at the University of Graz in the month of April 2020. The UGR may select **one member** of its teaching staff to participate in each of the two courses on offer, **one for teaching staff new to EMI** and **one for staff who are already teaching in English** and have attended previous staff development courses in the field.

Funding categories at the UGR:

- **Category 1 - Initial Certificate in Teaching in English**

Staff intending to begin teaching in English in the near future, and who can accredit a C1 level in English

- **Category 2 - Refresher course**

Staff already teaching in English on official undergraduate or postgraduate programmes and who have already attended staff development courses in the field.
