







LIFELONG LEARNING PROGRAMME – ERASMUS INTENSIVE PROGRAMME:

'Towards a Scientific Career: an Introductory Course for Research in Biomedicine and Biotechnology – BIOMED-TECH', GRANADA, SPAIN, 15TH – 26TH JULY, 2013

SCOPE

This course is designed to introduce students to a research career in the sphere of Biomedicine and Biotechnology, taking advantage of the particular strengths of CEI BioTic (the Campus of International Excellence of the University of Granada, Spain) as Coordinating Institution. The Partner Institutions of the Programme, working alongside the University of Granada (UGR) are the University of Nottingham (United Kingdom) and the University of Bayreuth (Germany). The research companies participating are Abbott Laboratories SA, Bio-Iliberis R&D, Neuron Bio and Fundación MEDINA. Renowned guest lecturers from universities and research centers external to the consortium will also collaborate. The programme is sponsored by the EACEA, OAPEE and UGR.

AIMED AT STUDENTS FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF GRANADA

The programme, which will be delivered in English, is aimed at master and PHD students of the UGR in the areas of Medicine, Biology, Pharmacy, Biochemistry and other biological and biotechnological sciences.

The number of participants is strictly limited to 5 students per participating University, to ensure an effective level of interaction between students and lecturers. The course will take place full-time from 15th to 26th July, 2013, in Granada.

- -Academic record (up to the point of achieving first degree)
- -Suitability of studies for the programme
- -Minimum average grade of 2, up to point of first degree
- -Scientific activities undertaken:
 - Conferences attended
 - Conference talks and other such inputs delivered
 - Scientific articles published
 - Visits or placements at other research centres or firms
- -Minimum level of competence in English of B1
