They were so excited and would not wait to see their design on the finished textile. All came out beautifully!

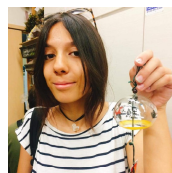
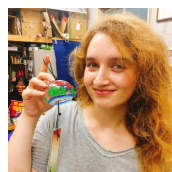


Bus Tour to Nikko

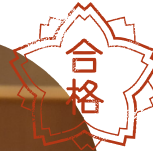
