INFORMATION ABOUT DOCTORAL PROGRAMMES

What is a doctorate?

A doctorate is a postgraduate degree that typically follows the acquisition of a master's degree and is designed to equip candidates with the skills and competencies to conduct high-quality scientific research.

What are the admission requirements?

Generally speaking, in order to enrol on a doctoral programme you must hold a bachelor's degree issued in Spain or an equivalent qualification, and a master's degree. International applicants must hold a degree issued in accordance with their national education systems, but do not require official recognition from the Spanish Ministry of Education (homologación), provided that the degree proves a level of training which is equivalent to that of an official master's degree (postgraduate level) in Spain and entitles you to enrol on a doctoral programme in the country of issue.
