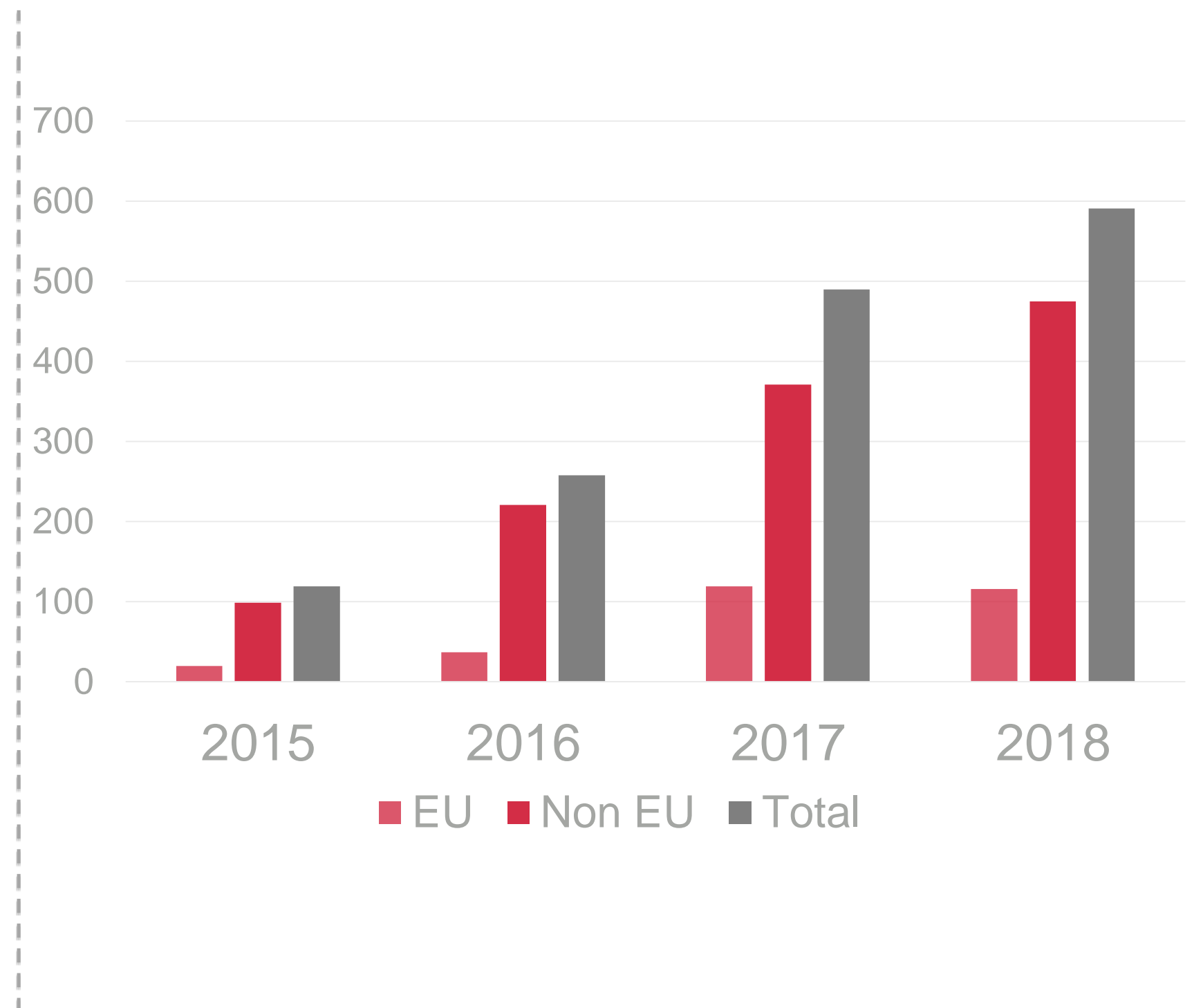

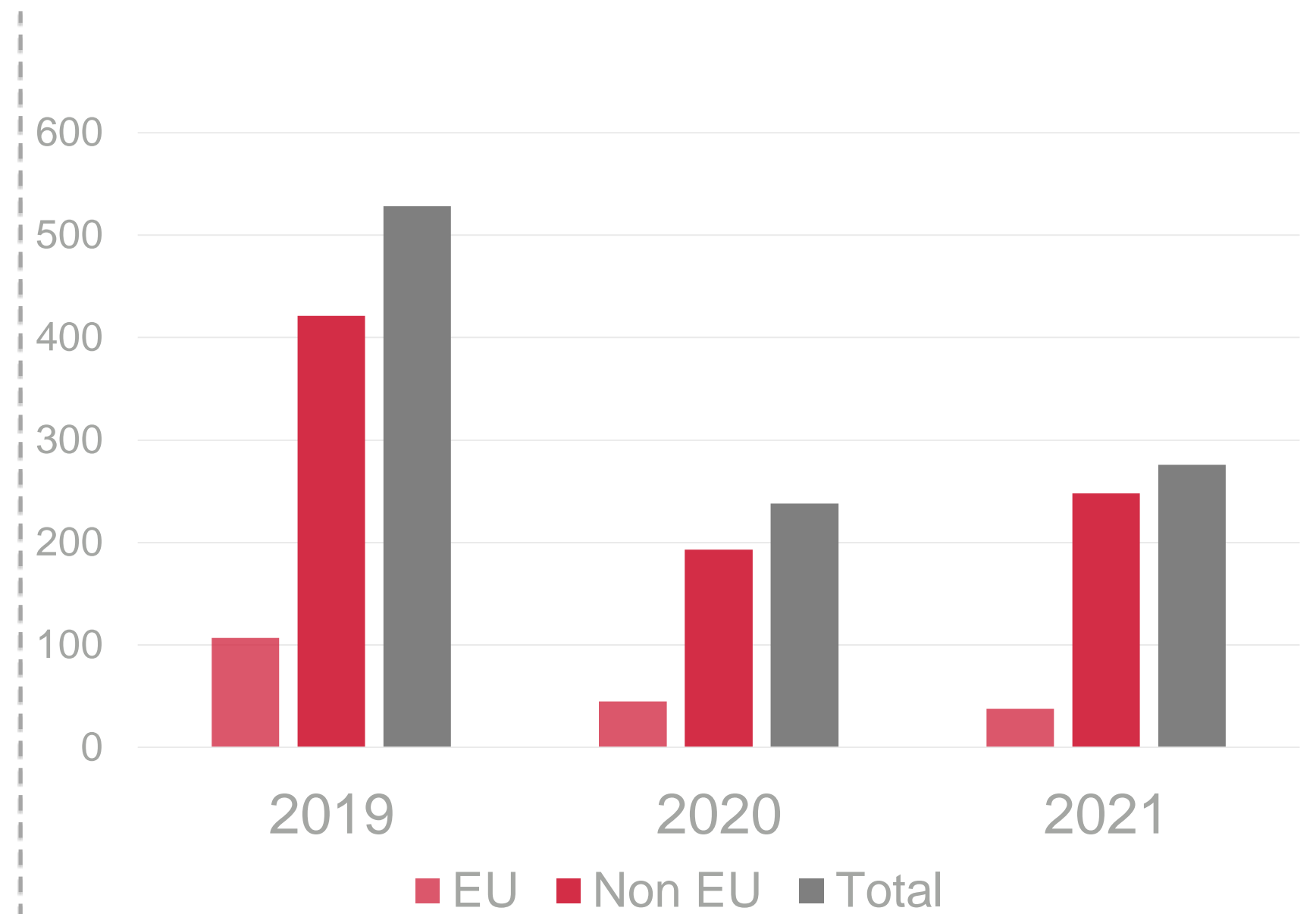

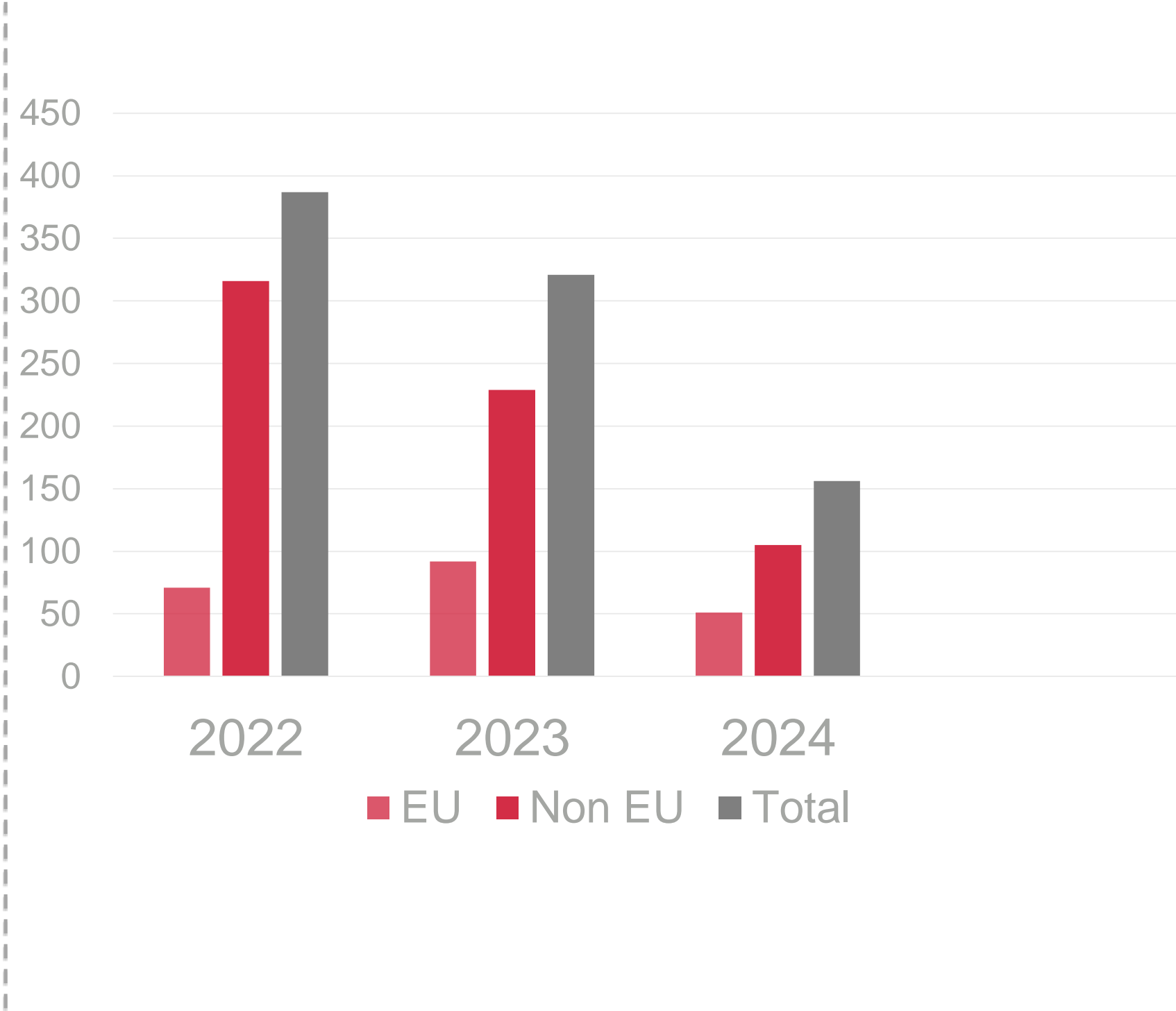

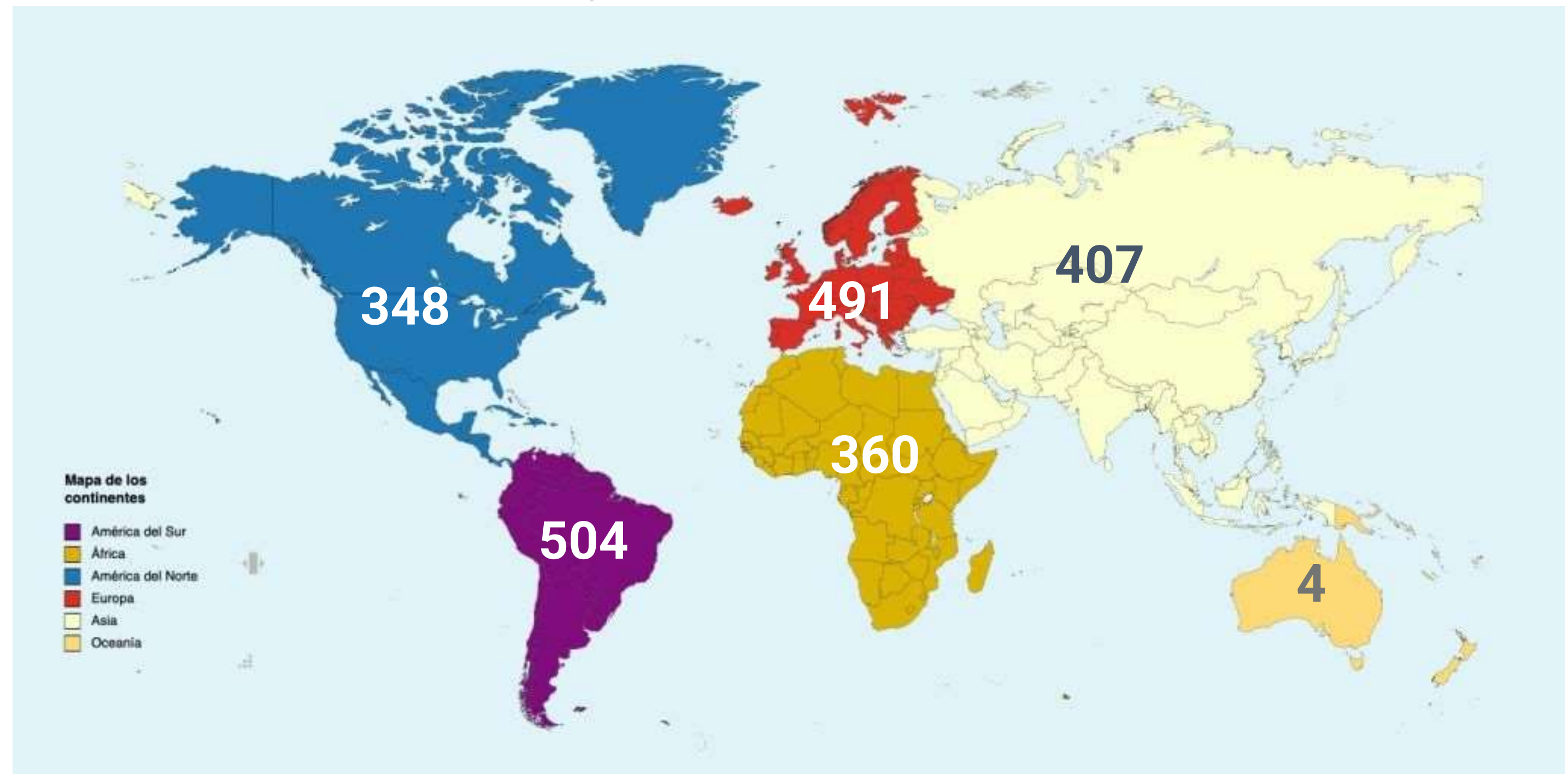

Our AAC (Agencia Andaluza del Conocimiento) is the regional contact point

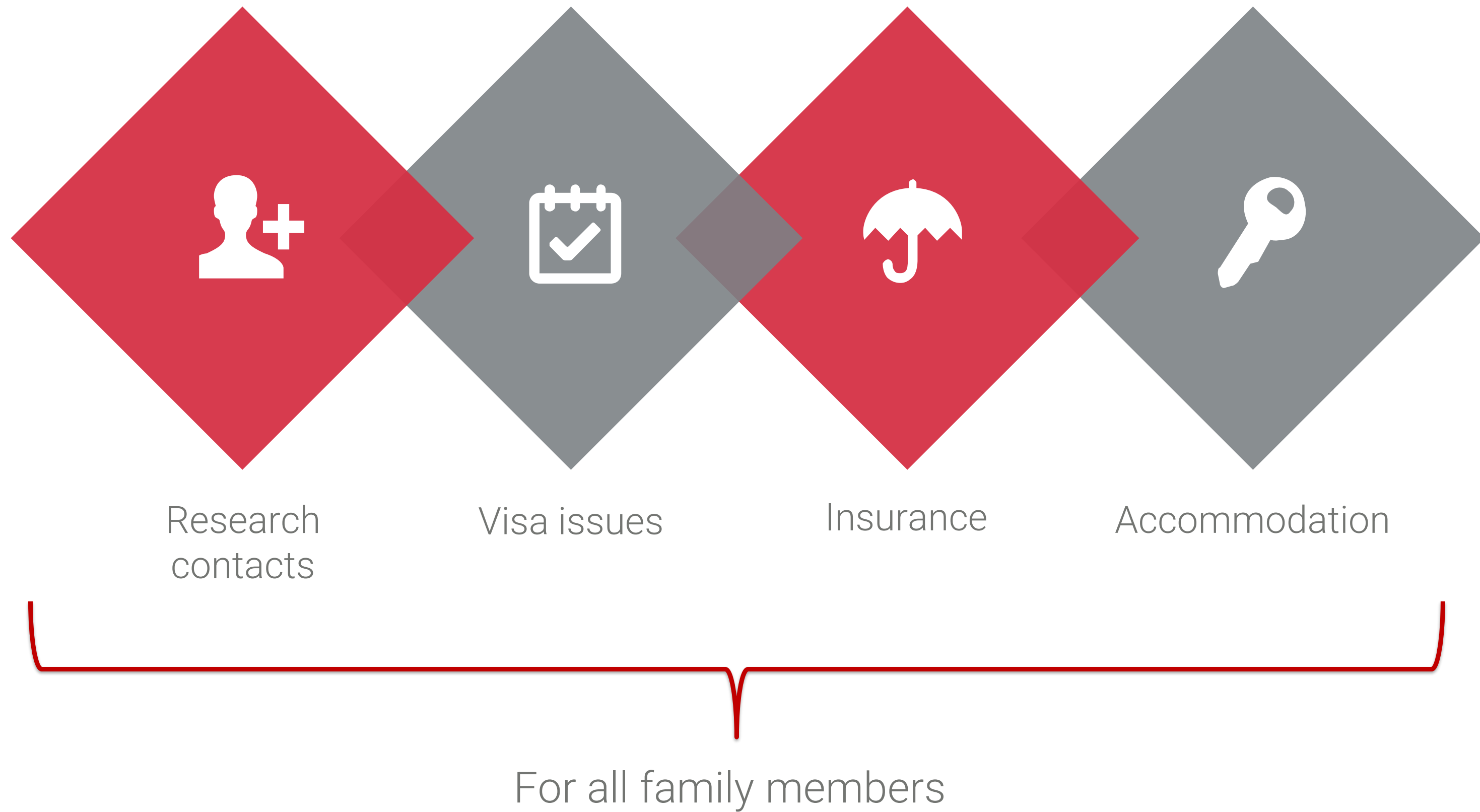

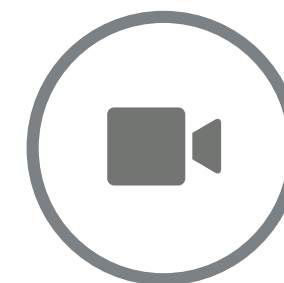
