APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. NOMINATION

The nomination should be sent to the following e-mail address: incoming@ugr.es
Please include the following information:

- Full name of your institution.
- Contact person (in charge of the management): full name and institutional e-mail.
- Candidate's full name
- Degree of study of each candidate at their <u>home university</u>.
- <u>Degree</u> which each candidate wish to pursue <u>at the UGR</u> and <u>level</u> of study in which they wish to register (undergraduate or postgraduate).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

3. APPLICATION DEADLINE

From **April 1st** till **May 15th** for mobilities starting in September (<u>first term and full year mobilities</u>).



From **October 1st** till **October 31st** for mobilities starting in February (second term mobilities).



4. LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

It is ESSENTIAL to have knowledge of the Spanish language equivalent to level B1 in order to be able to successfully pursue <u>UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES</u> at the UGR.

Regarding <u>postgraduate studies</u>, it will be mandatory to accredit a minimum level B1 in the language of instruction of the corresponding master programme.




